CRRA Coaches Code of Conduct

Coaches are expected to uphold the following standards:

- Encourage every player regardless of ability.
- Accept umpire decisions without anger, no matter how unfair the decision may seem. Always
 treat the umpire courteously. Remember that judgement calls, i.e. balls, strikes, safe/out, are
 not to be argued.
- Teach your players to treat umpires, other players, and coaches with the same respect that you do.
- Use of foul language/gestures is not permitted in any situation.
- Follow the rules at all times.
- Winning isn't everything. The ideal is the greatest good for the greatest number.
- Be positive in your words and actions. Be a good sport and role model.
- Attendance at coach's meetings is mandatory. If you are unable to attend, you are responsible for obtaining all information distributed at the meeting.
- Explain to your parents that they need to also be a positive role model for their players as well.
- Above all else have fun! It's a game after all!!
